#### 2-Day Program (3 Year Olds)

Tuesdays & Thursdays from 9:00am - 11:30am

Members - \$137/month; Non-Members - \$153/month

#### 3-Day Program (4 Year Olds)

Mondays, Wednesdays, & Fridays from 9:00am - 11:30am

Members - \$147/month; Non-Members - \$163/month

Our program follows the Baldwinsville Central School district calendar for scheduled days off and snow days. The 2022-2023 program starts Monday, September 12, 2022 and runs through Friday, June 9, 2023. Payments are due on the first day of the month. Our fee is based on total days in the program divided by 10 months of the payments. The rate does not change during shorter months.
