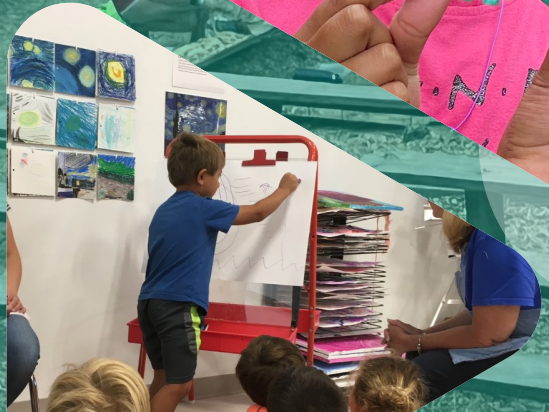

## IMPORTANT REGISTRATION AND MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

- Registration is happening in two waves this year: member-only registration beginning January 18th and open registration beginning January 25th.
- In order to qualify for member pricing, you must be a member of the YMCA of Central New York at the time of registration and sustain your membership through your camp season.
- If you have to cancel your membership before camp, you will be charged the non-member rate for your camp weeks, even if you rejoin before the summer.

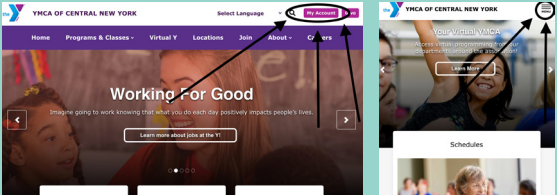




HOW TO REGISTER FOR CAMP

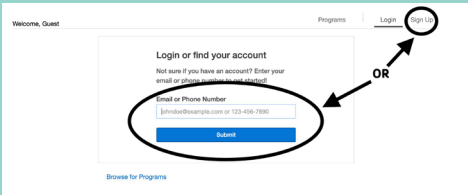
STEP ONE

Go to ymcacny.org and click on the My Account button the in top right corner (if you are on your phone, click the Menu button in the top right corner, then My Account)



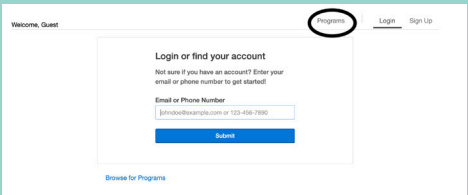
STEP TWO

Sign into your account if you have one. If you don't, click the Sign Up button to create a "Non-Member" account. There is no charge for the "Non-Member" account.



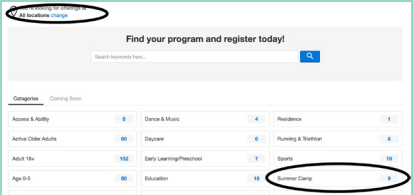
STEP THREE

Once you have signed in, click the Programs button on the top of the screen.



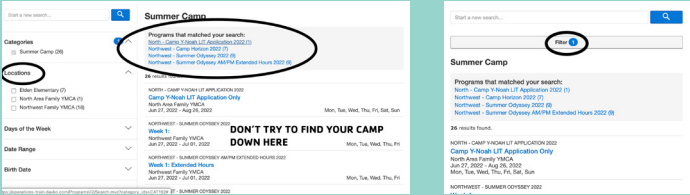
STEP FOUR

Find the program category labeled Summer Camp. If you cannot find that program label, make sure you have the Branch you are looking for selected at the top!



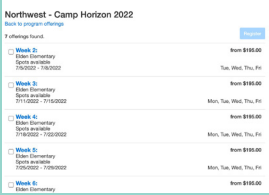
STEP FIVE

### OVERNIGHTS

(Completed 2nd Grade and older)

During the second Thursday of each session, we offer an opportunity for campers to spend the night at Evergreen and have some very special programming and ceremonies that are traditions as old as camp itself! Dinner and breakfast is provided. Registration will happen during the session!

### HORSE CAMP

(Completed 2nd Grade and older)

Join our end of summer favorite. Campers will be able to enjoy learning the basics of how to ride & care for horses. About half the day will be direct horse care and riding, and half the day will be camp activities and horse education. Camp will run during Week 9 (1 week experience).

# ACCESS & ABILITY SUPPORT



The YMCA of Central New York is proud to partner with AccessCNY to provide support services to children with special needs through the Office for People with Developmental Disabilities (OPWDD). Through this partnership, the Y is able to provide 1:1 or shared support counselors to children who qualify at no additional cost to the family. The Y also raises money during our annual campaign to provide support to campers who do not qualify for our grant funding. Campers of all abilities are able to enjoy summer camp in a safe, supportive, and inclusive environment.

Support counselors are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Each camper may receive support for 1 session (Camp Evergreen) or 2 weeks at other eligible camp locations.
